Where is my IP address?

- · Click the Start icon and select Settings.
- Click the Network & Internet icon.
- To view the IP address of a wired connection, select Ethernet on the left menu pane and select your network connection, your IP address will appear next to "IPv4 Address".

What apps did you share your google account with? Go into your google settings and select **Device activity & security events** - Scroll down and look at all the apps you gave access to your account. You can click on the ones you want to delete and remove access!

EXCEL comments

Did you know you can put comments anywhere in excel? They look like little sticky notes! Just click in the cell that you want to comment on and then select the *review tab*; and then select *new comment* or you can click in the cell and press ALT CR on your keyboard.

CAMTASIA – is the file size too big?

If you are having download issues with your files, the thing that will affect it most is the "Quality Slider". In the Custom Production settings, it is set by default to 50% (as in the screen shot above), but you can lower that to about 40% if you need to save on file size.

Also, if you don't have a lot of high-motion content in your video, you can set the frame rate to 15fps and it won't affect the quality at all!
