What is the difference between individuals and organizations that **succeed** in today's globalized, multicultural world and those that **fail?**





Your understanding about how cultures are similar and different.










DoD Norms vs. Global Norms









BEWARE!!!

Cultural knowledge by itself is worse than no knowledge!

CQ and DoD Opportunities


- 1. Establish benchmarks for cultural readiness
- 2. Evaluate and improve effectiveness of specific capability development. (e.g. CQ Strategy) through various training models (content, modality, etc.)
- 3. Use CQ1–CQ5 to monitor:
 - Officer's Cultural Readiness
 - Enlistee's Cultural Readiness
- 4. Combine with qualitative assessment (e.g. situational judgments).





